



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE UNIVERSITY OF NEWCASTLE, AUSTRALIA
AND
THE UNIVERSITY OF BRAWIJAYA, INDONESIA

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is made on the 19 day of Nov. 2013

1. PREAMBLE

- 1.1 Recognising the mutual benefits to be gained through a co-operative program promoting scholarly activities and international understanding, **The University of Newcastle** of University Drive, Callaghan, New South Wales, Australia and **The University of Brawijaya** of Jl. Veteran Malang, East Java, Indonesia enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (the 'Memorandum') and agree to the following:

2. PURPOSE

- 2.1 The purpose of this Memorandum is to facilitate and promote cooperation between the University of Newcastle and The University of Brawijaya by investigating opportunities to:
- (a) enable faculty and students from both institutions to participate in programs for study, research and research training
 - (b) develop joint courses and education programs
 - (c) undertake joint conferences, seminars and workshops
 - (d) collaborate in the capacity building of The University of Brawijaya faculty members/academics and staff in priority training areas set by the Ministry of Education

3. FURTHER AGREEMENTS

- 3.1 This Memorandum expresses only the intentions of the parties. The expressed intentions are not binding and no legally binding obligations are intended to, or do, arise as a consequence of the signing of this Memorandum. Actions taken by any party in reliance on this Memorandum will be at that party's sole risk.
- 3.2 Specific activities, projects, relevant funding and other matters relating to the implementation of the Memorandum shall be negotiated and executed under separate binding agreements.

- 3.3 The aforesaid separate binding agreements shall cover:
- (a) the responsibilities of each institution;
 - (b) selection and enrolment of students;
 - (c) the selection of visiting scholars and postgraduate students;
 - (d) research collaboration arrangements;
 - (e) financial considerations; and
 - (f) any other items necessary for the achievement of the proposal.

4. FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

- 4.1 The parties acknowledge that all or any financial arrangements proposed must be negotiated and will depend upon the availability of funds.

5. CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

- 5.1 The parties agree that, as at the date of the signing of this Memorandum, to the best of their knowledge, no conflict of interest exists or is likely to arise in relation to the intention of the parties to co-operate under this Memorandum. If, during the term of this Memorandum, a conflict or potential conflict of interest arises for one of the parties, then that party will immediately notify the other party in writing of that conflict or potential conflict of interest.


6. TERM OF MEMORANDUM

- 6.1 The term of this Memorandum shall commence on the date hereinbefore written and shall continue for a period of five years thereafter.
- 6.2 Either party may terminate this Memorandum with a 90-day prior written notice to the other Party.
- 6.3 This Memorandum may be amended or varied from time to time provide that such amendment or variation is evidenced in writing and signed by the parties.
